- Measure and record data associated to manufacturing processes

#### **Qualifications:**

- Minimum of a High School Diploma or GED
- Required to read and write English, follow verbal instructions and use simple math

- One year of assembly line experience desired

- Knowledge of machines and tools, including their uses, repair, and maintenance
- Understanding written sentences and paragraphs in work related documents
- Giving full attention to what other people are saying, taking time to understand the points being made, asking questions as appropriate and not interrupting at inappropriate times
- Monitoring/Assessing performance of yourself, other individuals, or organizations to make improvements or take corrective action
- Performing routine maintenance on equipment and determining when and what kind of maintenance is needed
- Controlling operations of equipment or systems
- Repairing machines or systems using the needed tools

- Determining causes of operating errors and deciding what to do about it
- Managing one's own time and the time of others
- Understanding the implications of new information for both current and future problem-solving and decision-making
- Being aware of others' reactions and understanding why they react as they do.
- Teaching others how to do something
- Selecting and using training/instructional methods and procedures appropriate for the situation when learning or teaching new things
- Obtaining and seeing to the appropriate use of equipment, facilities, and materials needed to do certain work
- The ability to tell when something is wrong or is likely to go wrong. It does not involve solving the problem, only recognizing there is a problem
- The ability to speak clearly so others can understand you
- The ability to quickly move your hand, your hand together with your arm, or your two hands to grasp, manipulate, or assemble objects
- The ability to make precisely coordinated movements of the fingers of one or both hands to grasp, manipulate, or assemble very small objects
- The ability to remember information such as words, numbers, pictures, and procedures
- The ability to bend, stretch, twist, or reach with your body, arms, and/or legs
- The ability to make fast, simple, repeated movements of the fingers, hands, and wrists
- The ability to see objects or movement of objects to one's side when the eyes are looking ahead
- The ability to shift back and forth between two or more activities or sources of information
- The ability to lift 50 lbs.
- The ability to stand 8 hours per day
